MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE CHILD & FAMILY DEVELOPMENTAL CENTER, INC., D/B/A HORIZON CHARTER SCHOOL OF TAMPA

A meeting of the Board of Directors of the Child and Family Developmental Center, Inc., d/b/a Horizon Charter School of Tampa, was held on July 14, 2025, at 7235 West Hillsborough Avenue, Tampa, Florida. Present were board members Mrs. Sharon Wingo and Mr. Tim Fannin. Also present were Mrs. Sheila Thomley, CEO of Horizon Charter School of Tampa, Mrs. Pamala Leonard, Principal, Dr. Andrew Hicks, administrator and clinical psychologist and Mr. Steve Hicks, COO of LLL Licensing, Inc. The meeting date, time, location, and agenda were publicly posted.

The minutes from the April 28, 2025, Board of Directors meeting were presented and approved.

The financial statements were reviewed for the first 11 months of the 2024-25 fiscal year, including the balance sheet as of May 31, 2025, showing total equity of \$325,678. The budget report was presented (showing year-to-date revenues of \$2,804,715 and expenses of \$2,766,383) along with the proposed 2024-25 final budget (showing revenues of \$3,041,935 and expenses of \$3,041,146) and the 2025-26 preliminary budget (showing revenues of \$3,155,646 and expenses of \$3,142,122). The balance sheet, budget report, final budget and preliminary budget were accepted.

Mrs. Leonard reported qualifications and duties of all staff individually (refer to 6-page addendum "Horizon Charter School Quarterly Board Meeting July 14, 2025"). Certifications and endorsements of all teachers were reviewed individually and were satisfactory to the board. Mrs. Thomley reported that 339 students are enrolled for the 2025-26 school year. The school received an "A" grade for the 2024-25 school year. Assessment updates were provided.

The grant-funded external lighting project is to begin soon. The FEMA grant to replace the damaged gates and ball field is in the approval process.

The Centegix school safety system upgrade is complete. The school district has moved to FOCUS for the Student Information System. Clearinghouse fingerprinting procedures were discussed. Changes to School Recognition Funds were discussed.

The board again received an update on the Comprehensive Reading Plan and approved its continued use. The Mental Health Plan was discussed and approved by the board. The board approved a minor uniform change to the student handbook. No changes were made to the employee handbook. The board meeting schedule for 2025-26 was approved.

No public items were placed on the agenda.

The next board meeting is scheduled for October 6, 2025. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

Present were board members Mrs. Sharon Wingo, Mr. Tim Fannin and Mrs. Julie Gant. Also present were Mrs. Sheila Thomley, CEO of Horizon Charter School of Tampa, Mrs. Pamala Leonard, Principal, Dr. Andrew Hicks, administrator and clinical psychologist, Dr. Eric Larson, President of LLL Licensing, Inc., and Mr. Steve Hicks, COO of LLL Licensing, Inc. The meeting date, time, location, and agenda were publicly posted.

The minutes from the January 27, 2025, Board of Directors meeting were presented and approved.

The financial statements were reviewed for the first eight months of the 2024-25 fiscal year, including the balance sheet as of February 28, 2025, showing total equity of \$381,118. The budget report was presented (showing year-to-date revenues of \$2,134,813 and expenses of \$2,041,040 and showing a revised annual budget of \$3,095,617 total revenue and \$3,094,828 total expenses). The separate Developmental Center Counseling & Evaluation balance sheet and income & expenses through March 31, 2025, were also presented. The balance sheets and budget reports were accepted.

Mrs. Leonard reported qualifications and duties of all staff individually (refer to 6-page addendum "Horizon Charter School Quarterly Board Meeting April 28, 2025"). Certifications and endorsements of all teachers were reviewed individually and were satisfactory to the board. Mrs. Thomley reported that 335 students are currently enrolled for the 2025-26 school year. The student trip to Tallahassee was very successful. Assessment updates were provided, including writing tests and Spring WIDA Access.

No changes have been made to the Pupil Progression Plan. The Centegix Safety Platform is being upgraded the week of May 26, 2025. HCST uses FortifyFL and Crimestoppers as crime watch tools. FLDOE moved to fingerprinting through the state Clearinghouse on April 7, 2025, but the system is not yet operational. Hillsborough County Public Schools will move to FOCUS as a student information system for 2025-26.

The school procurement committee met on April 3, 2025. The minutes of that meeting and decisions of the committee were presented to the board. The school is awaiting approval from FEMA to cover some of the costs of replacement of the entry gates and baseball field.

All board members signed conflict of interest policy acknowledgements.

No public items were placed on the agenda.

The next board meeting is scheduled for July 14, 2025. There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.

- Damage due to Hurricane Milton is still being assessed. We have applied for a FEMA grant for Repair or replacements will be needed for gates and baseball field. Procurement Policy and Committee met on April 3, 2025 to discuss FEMA estimates.

Assessment Update:

- PM3 began on April 1, 2025 with the Writing test and will continue through the 3rd week in May.
- Spring WIDA Access was completed successfully.

Etc:

- Reminder: Fortify Florida and Crimestoppers are our Crime Watch tools.
- Fingerprinting: The state has moved to the Clearinghouse Fingerprinting as we have indicated several months ago. That change occurred 4-7-25 and we are still unable to process any new employee.
- Centegix upgrade will be implemented the week of May 26, 2025.
